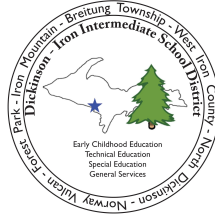


COMMUNITY EVENT
RAPID COVID TESTING

EVENT - Dickinson-Iron ISD is pleased to announce a community event for anyone interested in having a FREE rapid COVID test. This event will be from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 5th in the parking lot of Kingsford High School, 431 Hamilton Avenue, Kingsford, Michigan. The date of this testing is to coincide with the ending of our local school's spring break when people may have traveled outside the area. However, testing will be provided to anyone of any age who shows up at the testing site.

REGISTRATION - There will be health providers performing the COVID rapid tests and distributing the results. It is HIGHLY encouraged to fill out a pre-registration form for each person that would like to be tested. Completion of this form normally takes 4 to 5 minutes per person. TESTING - Please enter the Kingsford high school parking lot from the Pyle Drive entrance, not the Hamilton Avenue entrance. There will be signage to assist you once you arrive. You will drive-thru to the testing site and give confirmation of a completed registration or be directed to fill out a registration and come back in line. You will be given the rapid test while remaining in your vehicle. Once a rapid test has been completed, you will receive your results by phone or text within approximately 15 to 30 minutes. There will be a designated area if you choose to wait for your text or phone call results. If you have a negative result, nothing further is necessary. If you have a positive result, you can come back to the same testing site and get a PCR (comprehensive COVID test) which takes 48 to 72 hours for results. If you are unable to come back to this location for your PCR test due to time or other constraints, you should schedule an appointment with a different provider. If you get the PCR test at this site, you will be provided with information related to how you will get your results.
