

Parents,

It is our responsibility to inform you that West Iron County High School did not meet the State of Michigan's designation of "making AYP". AYP stands for Adequate Yearly Progress.

Although our ACT scores are above the state average in English and Reading, English Language Arts is the area in which we did not meet the state requirements. The State average for ELA is 52% of the students achieved a score of "1" or "2" on the MME exam. 49% were level 2 and 3% were level 1. At West Iron, we had 44% score at level 1 and 2, with 40% scoring at level 2 and 4% at level 1.

The staff and administration at West Iron are dedicated to increasing these scores, and not having AYP be an issue in the future.
